The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.5 – Sikandar in case FIR No.271 dated 16.08.2020, registered under Sections 376, 354-A, 354-D and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sohana, District Mohali.

Before approaching this Court, petitioner submitted various representations to the official respondents No.2 to 4 for taking appropriate

legal action against respondent No.5. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into her representation dated 27.08.2020 (Annexure P-3).

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representations, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, District Mohali – respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 27.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation dated 27.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) be communicated to respondent No.3 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
