This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved by petitioner seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to file status report with regard to complaints dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P/6) and 18.03.2021 (Annexure P/7) moved by petitioner with further prayer for protection of life and liberty of petitioner and his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made complaints/representations on 08.03.2021 and 18.03.2021 to respondents No.2 and 3 to (Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar and Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural), copies of which are available on the file as Annexures P/6 and P/7 respectively, but still no action has been taken.
