Prayer in this writ petition primarily is that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 06.02.2020 (Annexure P-13), apart from other representations which were earlier submitted, for release/return of land which had earlier been acquired for the purpose of setting up of Instruments Landing Station (I.L.S.), which according to the petitioner, till date, has not been set-up. The said representation which has been submitted to the Director, Airports Authority of India, Amritsar – respondent No.3, is under consideration with the said respondent as it is apparent that there has been a communication between respondent No.3 i.e. Director, Airports Authority of India, Amritsar and respondent No.2 i.e. Airports Authority of India, Department of Land Management, New Delhi.

Counsel for the petitioner, therefore, asserts that the petitioner,

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at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to these two respondents to consider and finally take a decision on the representation dated 06.02.2020 (Annexure P-13) submitted by the petitioner within some specified time.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Arun Gosain, learned Senior Government Counsel for Union of India, who has put in appearance, could not oppose the prayer which has been made by the counsel for the petitioner.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Chairman/Director/Executive Director, Airports Authority of India, Department of Land Management, New Delhi – respondent No.2 and the Director, Airports Authority of India, Amritsar – respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 06.02.2020 (Annexure P-13) submitted to respondent No.3, within a period of eight weeks from today.

Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
