Copy of judgment dated 16.01.2018 (Annexure P/2) alongwith copy of decree-sheet of even date passed in HMA Petition No.359 of 2017 titled 'Sumandeep Kaur Vs. Dhanna Singh' under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, in terms of which, exparte judgment and decree for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce was passed, is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

CRM is allowed.

Main Case

This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondents No.5 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation dated 23.03.2021 to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion confined to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, to look into and decide representation dated 23.03.2021 (Annexure P/1) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
