Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks 'remedial action' on his complaint dated 2.3.2021 (Annexure P-6), submitted to various police officers, including the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur.

Mr. Dadwal submits that despite the fact that the petitioner has been defrauded of approximately Rs. 1.65 Crores by respondents No. 7 to 9 (as alleged), no action has been taken by the police.

As per learned counsel, the said respondents even obtained money from the petitioner to pay off the mortgage on the land in question which earlier had been shown to be encumbrance free in the agreement of sale (as contended), and thereafter also, a further loan has been taken by the respondents qua the same land.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to go into the complaint made by the petitioner on 2.3.2021 (copy annexure P-6), and to take action if any is

found to be required, if any cognizable offence is made out, after duly enquiring into the matter.

The decision in that regard be taken by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
