This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of direction to official respondents to complete investigation in Rapat No.36 dated 15.08.2020 (Annexure P/3) under Sections 148, 323 and 324 IPC read with Section 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), recorded in case FIR No.166 dated 13.08.2020 under Sections 148, 323, 452 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation dated 15.02.2021 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/6, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, to look into and decide representation dated 15.02.2021 (Annexure P/6) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
