The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation Annexure P-1 made by the petitioner for appointing/start process for appointing /substitutes the Lambardar of General/ Backward Class in the village Dhantori, District Kurukshetra, since the post of Lambardar in General Category is vacant due to death of Jeet Singh ten years ago and post of Backward Class is lying vacant due to absence of Sukhwinder Singh, Lambardar since he left India in January 2020 to settle aboard.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he would be satisfied if respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation (Annexure P-1) within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. S. S. Pannu, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of the prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to decide the representation made by the petitioner; attached with the petition at Annexure P-1, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
