Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.49 dated 19.03.2020, under Sections 406, 498-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station City Batala, District Gurdaspur.

By virtue of the order dated 13.05.2020 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
