The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a cross-case bearing Rapat No.26 dated 31.05.2020 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 in FIR No.110 dated 30.05.2020, lodged under Sections 354-A, 341, 324, 323, 148, 149, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Lambi, Batala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to order dated 22.04.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation. He has further stated that it is a case of version and cross version wherein both the parties had received injuries at the hands of each other and the cross case is a counter blast to the FIR in question which was got registered by the complainant a day prior of its registration. This fact is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Krishan Lal, states that the petitioners are no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the aforesaid, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 22.04.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
