Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection
of their life and liberty pleading that both of them are major and have
performed marriage against the wishes of their parents and family members
of petitioner No.1 and there is threat to their life and liberty.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice
on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that a
representation (Annexure P-5) has been submitted to respondent No.2
seeking necessary protection but no action has been taken so far in the
matter.

Learned State counsel has submitted that necessary directions
be given to the concerned authorities to look into the matter.

In the light of the above, without examining the question of validity of the marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action, as per law, if situation so warrants.
