Case taken up through video conferencing.

After arguing for sufficient time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition but a direction be issued to the trial Court to expedite the trial.

On being asked, learned State counsel has contended that charge has since been framed against the accused and next date of hearing before the trial Court is 2.2.2021 for prosecution evidence and out of 12 Pws cited, none has been examined so far.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The trial Court is directed to make earnest efforts to conclude the trial expeditiously by giving short adjournments, refusing to grant adjournment except for justifiable reasons, which are to be recorded in the order. The State shall cause appearance of the prosecution

witnesses on each date so fixed. Of course, no unnecessary adjournment would be asked on behalf of the accused, if trial is to proceed expeditiously. The necessary exercise be completed preferably within a period of 08 months from the date of receipt of copy of order there.
