The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the subject matter and further direct respondent No.3 to register FIR on the basis of DDR bearing No.25, dated 19.03.2021, Police Station Jamalpur, Ludhiana, against respondents No.4 to 13. Prayer has also been made to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that for her grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation, dated 09.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) to the Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana i.e. respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. A.S.Gill, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana, to take a decision on the representation dated 09.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
