the petitioner has already moved a representation dated 1.3.2021 (Annexure

On this, learned State counsel submits that direction can be
given to the concerned authority to look into the matter.

the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to

respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to consider and decide representation dated 1.3.2021 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner, as per law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
