Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 92 dated 02.04.2021, under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Section 21 (4) of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957, registered at Police Station Pratap Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of almost four months in registering the FIR. The tractor-trolley owned by the petitioner had been confiscated. He also contends that the tractor-trolley owned by the petitioner was only loading and unloading gravel within the premises of the screening plant. The petitioner is not involved in any other similar case.

This Court, by the order dated 20.04.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Navtej Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 20.04.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
