Petitioners seek grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.399 dated 02.12.2019, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at P.S. Phillaur, Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 15.05.2020 passed by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, petitioners were granted interim bail on the strength of **Inderjit Singh @ Ladi vs. State of Punjab & Ors., Crimes 308** till receipt of FSL report. Thereafter vide order dated 08.09.2020 interim bail was discontinued and the petitioners were directed to surrender within one week from 08.09.2020 before the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The failure on the part of the petitioners would have entailed their arrest by the Police/Investigating Agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that despite his repeated instructions to the petitioners, they have not surrendered before the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mohan Singh also asserted that the petitioners have not surrendered before the concerned Court despite the order dated 08.09.2020 and they have misused the concession of interim bail.

In view of aforesaid factual position, no indulgence can be granted in favour of the petitioner. The Investigating Officer of the case is directed to arrest the petitioners forthwith.

The present petition stands dismissed with the aforesaid direction.
