The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

CRM-13280 of 2021

The application is allowed subject to all just exceptions.

Copy of order (Annexure P-6) annexed with the application is taken on record.

Main petition

This is a petition seeking permission for release of passport to go to Canada to enable the petitioner to meet new born grand son. The petitioner was granted bail in FIR No. 10 dated 17.8.0217, under Sections 406, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 477-A, 120-B IPC and Sections 13(1)(d) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Flying Squad-I, Punjab Mohali by this Court on 20.3.2018.

On 23.4.2021, learned counsel for the petitioner sought time to place on record copy of order dated 2.11.2017 in which according to him, the condition was imposed on the petitioner not to leave India without prior permission of the Court.

The petitioner has filed CRM-13280 of 2021 for placing on record order dated 6.11.2017, same is taken on record.

From the order, it is forth coming that there were allegations against Gurdev Singh Syan leaving from Delhi to London and he was apprehended from Delhi Airport.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it was a case of mistaken identity which was clarified later on and the petitioner was not there at the Airport.

The order making the interim bail absolute is annexed with the petition. In spite of the fact that the petitioner was not found at the Airport as per learned counsel for the petitioner, yet conditions vide order dated 2.11.2017 were imposed.

In view of the fact that there are allegations of leaving the country, the \ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to move an application in the petition by which he was granted anticipatory bail and the conditions were imposed.
