This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to step up pay of petitioner; being Senior Category Employee; at par with his junior counterparts of Reserved Category Employees as per the judgment of this Court in ***CWP No.17280 of 2011, Prem Kumar Verma and others Vs. State of Haryana***, decided on 07.08.2012 and also direct the respondents to release all accrued benefits along with interest @ 18% per annum from the due date till its realization. It is further prayed that the respondents be directed to consider the case of the petitioner and take the final decision on the representation of the petitioner dated 02.12.2020 (Annexure P-5) by passing a well reasoned speaking order within a time bound frame.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the representation of the petitioner dated 02.12.2020 (Annexure P-5) and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 02.12.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of three months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
