Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.24 dated 15.11.2018, under Sections 420 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code (added offences under Sections 494 and 120-B IPC, 1860 and Section 12-A of Passport Act, 1967 vide Entry dated 26.01.2019) at Police Station NRI, District Police Commssionerate Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 04.04.2019, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer for grant of ancitpatory bail to the petitioners.

In view of the above, interim order dated 04.04.2019 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
