for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.210 dated 12.11.2019 registered
under Sections 61/1/14 Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Samana,
District Patiala.

For the relief claimed in the present petition the petitioner had
earlier approached this Court through CRM-M-3524-2021 – Nishan Singh
@ Pammi vs. State of Punjab which petition of his was dismissed by this
Court on 24.03.2021 through the following order:-

*“The arguments raised on behalf of the petitioner
having not received a favourable response from the Bench and
not invite a decision on merits lest it may prejudice the case of
the petitioner at a later stage, learned counsel for the
petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.*

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner without there being any change in circumstance after the dismissal of his first petition through the afore quoted order.

In view of the above and because the petitioner is alleged to have committed the crime, which is the subject matter of the present petition, while on bail in another case of similar nature, no ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail.
