The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, Rimpny and Amit, who are of a marriageable age, have married on 09.04.2021 against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5, who are relatives of petitioner No.1. They apprehend threat to their life from the aforesaid respondents.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Viranjeet Singh Mahal, Additional Public Prosecutor, who has been served with the advance copy of the petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. He has filed the copies of the statements of respondents No.4 and 5 recorded by the police authorities, wherein both the respondents have stated that they have not extended any threat to the petitioners.

In view of the above, no orders are called for.

Petition is disposed of.
