Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.0030 dated 04.03.2021 registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC at Police Station City-I, Malerkotla.

By virtue of the order dated 15.04.2021, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that in pursuance to the order dated 15.04.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
