It has been stated that both the petitioners have attained the age for a valid marriage. The marriage of the petitioners has been solemnized on 01.12.2020. It has been further stated that petitioner no.1 is a divorcee. Copy of aadhar card, marriage certificate and photographs are on record. The petitioners are stated to be residing at Balibeg Colony, Near Charan Kanwal Sahib Gurdwara, Machhiwara Khas, Ludhiana. Apprehending danger to their lives, at the instance of private respondents, who are the relatives of the petitioners, the present petition has been instituted. It has been stated that petitioners have already submitted a representation (Annexure P/6) to respondent no.2 – Senior Superintendent

of Police, Khanna. The allegations are also substantiated with the affidavit of petitioner no.1.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. H.S. Multani, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna to look into the matter and if he finds that apprehension of danger to the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners is real, he shall take appropriate steps to ensure their protection as he feels necessary, in such circumstances of the case.

This order is not to be construed as any opinion with regard to the age of the petitioners or factum or validity of their marriage or any civil or criminal proceedings.
