A Coordinate Bench of this Court on 16.04.2021 had passed the following order:-

“The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 16 dated 22.1.2021 under Section 380, 457 IPC registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.

Briefly, the FIR has been registered at the instance of Gulwinder Singh alleging that on 11.1.2021, the petitioner along with Resham Singh, Laddi, Jaggu Singh and Sarabjit Singh committed the theft of tractor, buffalo and a bull.

It has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case, there is delay of 11 days in lodging the FIR, the petitioner has been falsely named in the FIR, the co-accused Laddi has been arrested, the recovery of tractor has already been effected from him and the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Notice of motion.

Mr. H.S.Multani, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 14.7.2021.

Meanwhile, it is directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be admitted on interim bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer subject to the condition that he join the investigation and comply with other conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Angrej, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but recovery of animals is yet to be effected.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 16.04.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
