It has been stated that both the petitioners have attained the age for a valid marriage. The marriage of the petitioners has been solemnized on 03.04.2021. Copy of aadhar card and marriage certificate are on record. The petitioners are stated to be residing at Village Dhanana, Aladadpur, Sonapat. Apprehending danger to their lives, at the instance of private respondents, who are the relatives of the petitioners, the present petition has been instituted. The allegations are also substantiated with the affidavits of both the petitioners.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajneesh Chadwal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that he has not received copy of the paper-book. Learned counsel for the petitioners has assured to pass over the paper-book to the learned State counsel through E-mail/WhatsApp during the course of the day.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 – Superintendent of Police, Sonapat to look into the matter and if he finds that apprehension of danger to the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners is real, he shall take appropriate steps to ensure their protection as he feels necessary, in such circumstances of the case.

This order is not to be construed as any opinion with regard to the age of the petitioners or factum or validity of their marriage or any civil or criminal proceedings.
