The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.192 dated 09.03.2021 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

On 22.04.2021 following order was passed:-

Case taken up through Video Conferencing.

Relies on the ad interim anticipatory bail granted by this Court to the co-accused Satpal in CRM-M-15776-2021 – Satpal vs. State of Haryana.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Ashok Kumar Sehrawat, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Adjourned to 14.07.2021.

To be heard along with CRM-M-15776-2021.

Subject to deposit of Rs. 2 lakhs in the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Narnaul within 15 days and the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.192, dated 09.03.2021, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

It is clarified that the above deposited amount shall be disbursed to the State against security and will be subject to the final orders to be passed in the petitioner's trial.
