AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This is a petition seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 280 dated 12.10.2020, under Sections 20 and 61 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Lakhan Majra, District Rohtak.

In CRM-M-15760 of 2021 earlier filed by the petitioner, the following order was passed on 9.4.2021:

“After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within one week from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner surrenders within one week from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within two days and decide it as expeditiously as possible.”

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner when confronted with the fact that on 9.4.2021 the aforesaid order was passed, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
