The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 19 dated 11.01.2021 under Sections 67 of the Information Technology Act and Sections 313, 376-D IPC registered at Police Station Samalka, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioners are falsely implicated in the present case and on instructions of this Court dated 20.04.2021, they have joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dharambir, submits that the matter has been investigated and a cancellation report has

been prepared. The petitioners has joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated qua the petitioner and the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 20.04.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
