2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.154 dated 21.12.2020 registered under Sections 353, 186, 148, 149, 332 IPC and Sections 21 & 22, NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 16.04.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that her custodial interrogation is not required.
