The Court has been convened through Video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Gurdeep Singh son of Amrik Singh (petitioner No.1) claims to be 23 years and Resham Kaur @ Reshma Bhatti daughter of Jagsir Singh (petitioner No.2) claims to be 17½ of age. They have pleaded that they are in live-in relationship against the wishes of respondents No.5 and 6 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.5 and 6.

The petitioners have submitted a representation Annexure P-3 to the official respondents No.2 to 4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has relied upon a judgment of this Court in ***CWP No.31834 of 2019 titled as "Megha and another vs. State of Haryana and others"*** decided on 04.11.2019 and submitted that this Court had entertained petition for protection of couples in live-in relationship.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, the petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-3 and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
