Heard through video conferencing.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their peaceful and happy married life at the behest of respondents No.4 to 7.

Petitioners before this Court, claim themselves to be of marriageable age. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents no.4 to 7 and seek protection of their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 7. They have placed on record Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-4, evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 14.04.2021, Annexure P-3 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rural Amritsar.

Vide order dated 16.04.2021, this Court issued notice of motion to the respondents and directed them to look into the representation, Annexure P-3. Official respondents No.1 to 3 have filed an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural, wherein it has been stated that the statements of the parties have been recorded. However, the affidavit does not show as to whether the representation, Annexure P-3, submitted by the petitioners has been examined.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the representation, Annexure P-3.

Request made by counsel has been considered.

Without examining the averments made in the writ petition or in the representation submitted by the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rural Amritsar, respondent No.2. to examine the representation, Annexure P-3, and take suitable action thereon as warranted, in accordance with law.

A copy of this order as well as copy of the representation, Annexure P-3, be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rural Amritsar - respondent No.2, in order to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

It is made clear that order passed by this Court will not be taken as a stamp of approval on the relationship of the parties.
