The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents No.2 and 3 to provide adequate security and protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners, who apprehend threat from respondent No.4.

In response to notice issued to official respondents No.1 to 3, reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sirsa has been filed wherein it has been stated that the petitioners never sought any protection from the respondents nor did they ever report any danger to their life and liberty. It has further submitted that in compliance of order dated

28.04.2021, the statements (Annexure R-1 and R-2) of both the petitioners have been recorded.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter has been compromised and he does not want to pursue the petition and requests for withdrawal of the same.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
