By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR no. 0059 having been registered at Police Station City Muktsar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, on 08.03.2021, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under the provisions of Section 306 of the IPC.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official who is present today to assist him, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 23.04.2021 and presently her custodial interrogation is not required, as she is also stated to have surrendered her mobile phone in terms of the directions issued by this court vide the aforesaid order.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, she would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon her.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he would be always at liberty to avail of his remedy as per law.
