The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.489 dated 16.08.2020 registered under Sections 148, 149, 307 IPC and under Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Sirsa City, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 20.04.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the alleged gun shot was fired by one Kamal and recovery has been effected from him. Only one injury was found on the person of the injured that too on cheek.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwan Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that talwar has been effected from him.

Whether talwar has been used in the occurrence or not would remain debatable.

In view of above, order dated 20.04.2021 is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
