Case heard by video conference.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to take stern action against respondents no.4 to 7, who are (as alleged), continuously harassing and threatening him and his family and and trying interfere in the peaceful possession of his land while not allowing him to harvest the wheat crop.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if his representation to the SSP, Sri Muktsar Sahib, dated 13.04.2021 (copy Annexure P-4), is disposed of expeditiously, as the petitioner (allegedly) is not being allowed to harvest his wheat crop.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2, i.e., the SSP, Sri Muktsar Sahib, to immediately go into the grievance of the petitioner and to take a decision as is required as per law, within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

A very short time is being given due to the fact that if the allegations are found to be true, obviously the wheat crop needs to be harvested immediately in this season.
