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**B.S. Walia, J. (VC)**

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through VideoConferencing due to Covid-19pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 46 dated 15.03.2021 registered under Sections 384 and 389 IPC to which Section 120-B IPC was added later on at Police Station Sadar Ratia, District Fatehabad.

3. On 23.04.2021, the following order was passed:-

“ Submits *inter alia* that no recovery was effected from the petitioner, who is a woman, and that the co-accused Nachhatar Singh @ Soni has been granted bail by the Ld. Court below.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Anmol Malik, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana to accept notice on behalf of the respondent/State. A copy of the Paper-book be supplied to him.

4. Adjourned to 17.08.2021.

5. *Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, she shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-*

*I. That she shall make herself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;*

*II. That she shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer and;*

*III. That she shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

4. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner contends while learned State counsel on instructions from *ASI Sajjan Singh* confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 23.04.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that her custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of learned State counsel, order dated 23.04.2021, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
