The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that both the petitioners are major and they have married out of their free will. It has been submitted that at present there is no apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has also stated that they are living happily together and have no apprehension to their life and liberty at the present moment and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Keeping in view, the above-said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to move a representation before respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala in case of any apprehension in future and in case such a representation is moved then respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
