This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the official respondents to consider and promote the petitioner to the post of Head Master of High School w.e.f. the date from which his juniors have been promoted vide order dated 15.03.2021 (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the petitioner candidly states that after publication of the said list, he has not approached the authorities by filing any representation. He would further contend that he limits his prayer in the present petition and states that the petitioner would be satisfied if this petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent no.2 – Director Secondary Education, Haryana – to treat the present petition as a representation on behalf of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG,

Haryana, who has joined the session through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has not filed any representation to the authorities, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent no.2 – Director Secondary Education, Haryana – to consider the present petition as a representation on behalf of the petitioner and to decide the same in accordance with law expeditiously and in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Disposed off accordingly.
