By this application (CRM-25102-2020), the applicant/petitioner seeks to place on record his affidavit, in terms of the order dated 30.09.2020, stating to the effect that he had joined investigation.

The affidavit would in fact be rendered infructuous in view of the fact that as per the instructions of learned State counsel, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required presently.

That being so, in fact even the petition itself (CRM-M-25402-2020) has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

[The petition is one by which the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.20, dated 31.01.2020, registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 306 of the IPC.]

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he/she would be always at liberty to avail of his/her remedy as per law.
