By the impugned order dated 24.03.2021 (Annexure P-1), the petitioner was directed to swap the place of posting with Sh. Rajesh Kumar, Junior Engineer in order to hold the elections in a smooth and fair manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the order passed by this Court in CWP No. 6941 of 2021 titled as **Narender Kumar Vs. Registrar, Cooperative Societies and others**, the elections have already been stayed and therefore, now, there is no reason with the respondents to implement the order dated 24.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) directed the swapping of post of the petitioner with Rajesh Kumar, Junior

Engineer any further. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that

the petitioner has already filed an application seeking pre-mature retirement w.e.f. June, 2021, which fact is also pending consideration with the authorities, hence transferring the petitioner at this stage will serve no useful purpose.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Virinder Dahiya, Managing Director of the Haryana State Co-operative Labour & Construction Federation Limited, submits that the order dated 24.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) impugned in the present petition, will not be implemented as of now and a fresh order will be passed if necessary, in case this Court allows the respondents to hold the election.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is satisfied keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents and his grievance stands redressed and therefore, he does not press this writ petition any further.

Ordered accordingly.
