The petitioner claims to have applied pursuant to a recruitment notice issued for filling up 440 posts of Lower Division Clerks. The petitioner claims that he cleared the written examination and was thereafter, called for scrutiny of the documents. The petitioner further claims that according to his calculation he has secured 83 marks in the written examination and he is entitled to 5 additional marks on the ground that no member of his family is working in a Government job. The final result of the written examination was declared on 15.04.2021, however, the petitioner did not find his name amongst the selected candidates.

Before filing the writ petition, the petitioner is stated to have made a representation to the Haryana Staff Selection Commission.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to request the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Punchkula, to consider the case of the petitioner after granting him an opportunity of hearing and pass a speaking order within a period of two months. If the claim of the petitioner is found meritorious, the Secretary

would pass consequential orders. However, if the claim of the petitioner is rejected, the Secretary is expected to pass a speaking order giving specific reasons for its rejection. Needless to observe that the petitioner shall be at liberty to file a fresh writ petition, if his claim is rejected.
