Petitioners herein, *inter alia*, seek issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to grant them parity in terms of order dated 06.02.2017 (Annexure P-2) as already passed by the learned Secretary, Cooperation in Revision Petition No. 312 of 2014 and release their lands (ancestral/inherited) from attachment as there is nothing due from them.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners also submitted a representation dated 12.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) but to no avail. Hence, the instant petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners would be satisfied, at this stage, if a final decision, either way, is taken by the respondents on the pending representation dated 12.02.2020 (Annexure P-1).

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioners as perrepresentation dated 12.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and decide the same, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
