By these petitions, the petitioners seek the concession of 'regular
bail' under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.0096,
dated 25.09.2019, having been registered at Police Station Sri Anandpur

Sahib, District Rupnagar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC.

No further prosecution witnesses having been examined since the last date of hearing, with the next date of hearing before the trial court being 03.05.2021 and the petitioners having been admitted to interim bail upon furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 15,00,000/- (15 lakhs) each and so far at least they not having misused the concession of bail, these petitions are allowed with the interim orders dated 22.01.2021 and 12.10.2020, passed in CRM-M-1487 of 2021 and CRM-s-13136 and 18198 of 2020, respectively, made absolute during the pendency of the trial.
