1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.337 dated 30.03.2018 at Police Station Central, District Faridabad, under Sections 420/465/468/471/120-B IPC.
2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 20.03.2019, the following order was passed:

“The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.337, dated 30.3.2018, registered at Police Station Central, District Faridabad, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC.

The allegations, in nutshell, are to the effect that a WILL in respect of Estate of Dilraj Singh Sekhon has been forged so as to benefit Rajwant Kaur and other members of the family and which had allegedly been attested by the present petitioners. Learned counsel has submitted that the beneficiary Rajwant Kaur has already been granted anticipatory bail by the learned trial

Court and that in these circumstances the petitioners who are the attesting witnesses are on a better footing. It has also been submitted that in fact as per the WILL in question, the property is not to be bequeathed only to Rajwant Kaur but also to other members of the family including the complainant.

3. Learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioners have since joined investigation and are not required for any custodial interrogation and that they are not wanted in any other case.

Having regard to the aforestated position, wherein the petitioners are stated to have joined investigation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 20.03.2019 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
