1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. This is a second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. The first was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 08.04.2021 in CRM-M-15527 of 2021 by granting liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and to move a petition for regular bail while issuing directions to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the petition for regular bail in a time bound manner by taking into account the old age of the petitioner and also of his suffering from a number of ailments.

3. Instant second petition has been filed praying for grant of anticipatory bail on account of the petitioner suffering from number of medical ailments. Aforementioned aspect of the matter was duly taken note of while dismissing the first petition as withdrawn. Accordingly, no new ground is made made out to interfere with the order dated 08.04.2021 in CRM-M-15527 of 2021 and the present petition is dismissed. Resultantly, the second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is dismissed.
