The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.37, dated 11.07.2020, registered under Section 307/452/450/324/323/326/506/34 IPC, at Police Station Block Majri, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner entered the house of the first informant and inflicted injuries to various persons with a spade.

The first informant and the petitioner are cousins. All the injured as well as the petitioner are members of a same larger family. On conclusion of the investigation, the challan has already been presented and the petitioner has suffered incarceration for a period of more than 4 months and 9 days. The conclusion of the trial is likely to take time.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has suffered incarceration for a period of more than 4 months and 9 days and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
