This is a petition for regular bail filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.137 dated 13.11.2019, under Sections 307 & 324 of the IPC (Sections 325, 326 & 326-A of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

[2]. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and complainant jointly submit that the complainant has no objection to the petitioner's being released on bail at this stage subject to his paying an amount of `1.5 lacs towards the medical expenses of the complainant.

[3]. In such circumstances, considering the detention undergone by the petitioner which is of almost 1 year and 2 months since 14.11.2019, at this stage he is permitted to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld.

Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

[4]. It is further clarified that acceptance of the aforesaid amount towards medical treatment expenses of the complainant shall be without any prejudice to the substantive right of the complainant to prosecute the petitioner. Further, the complainant would be at liberty to seek cancellation of this bail if the compensation amount is not paid within 10 days.
