The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeks directions to respondents No.2 3 namely the Deputy Commissioner, Hoshiarpur to take a decision on his representation Annexure P-10 and to pass an appropriate order under Rule 8 of the Punjab Arms Rules, 2017 qua the entry of the fire arm (Annexure P-3), which has been purchased from one Kuldeep Singh in the Arms License (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner.

Counsel has referred to various documents showing the necessary modalities which were carried out and submits that the entry in the Arms License of the petitioner has not been done and weapon is lying in the Police Station Model Town, Hoshiarpur. It is his case that the representation (Annexure P-10) thus be decided.
