In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he has been given School Leaving Certificate (Annexure P-2) dated 14.09.2020 though, the petitioner never wanted any School Leaving Certificate and the said School Leaving Certificate has been issued to him only to throw the petitioner out of the school without any valid justification.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Naveen Chopra, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-CBSE states that CBSE will examine the plea of the petitioner that under the garb of issuing School Leaving Certificate to the petitioner, the petitioner has been thrown out of the school though, he

still intends to continue study in the said school and appropriate order will be passed by the authority concerned in respect of the said grievance of the petitioner within a period of two months from today keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement given by learned counsel for respondent No.1, his grievance stands redressed and he does not press this writ petition any further.

Disposed of as not pressed.

It is made clear that before any order is passed by respondent No.1 on the grievance being raised by the petitioner, respondent No.2-School be also given an opportunity to present its case.
