Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

CRM-8310-2021 has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking permission to withdraw the main petition, which is fixed for hearing on 08.04.2021.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that the petitioner-husband and Varinderjit Kaur-wife were staying in Australia and the impugned FIR had been got registered by respondent No.2 (father-in-law of the petitioner) and that now the matter has been compromised between the parties. He further submits that now, the petitioner intends to file a petition, for quashing of the impugned FIR on the basis of the compromise.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

At this stage, Mr. Rishi Kaushal, Advocate, puts in an appearance and files his power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.2

through e-mail. Print out of the same is taken on record. He submits that he has no objection, if the present application is allowed.

Heard.

In view of the above, CRM-8310-2021 is allowed and while preponing the date of hearing in the main petition i.e. CRM-M-13583-2019 to that of today, the petitioner's prayer is allowed. The main petition is, thus, dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh one, seeking quashing of the impugned FIR on the basis of the compromise.
