Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.41 dated 17.03.2021 registered under Sections 452, 323, 325, 506 read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Shambhu, District Patiala.

Vide order dated 27.04.2021 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 27.04.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmukh Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.
